

Past and present reflections – RCAF History to Deep Space by Linda Brimson

427 Wing didn't host its 98th RCAF anniversary luncheon on March 31, 2023 because we didn't meet a minimum number of attendees. In the past, this would be a well-attended event. It is a sign of decreasing Wing membership that sadly, we are not able to gather the number of people needed to host a larger dinner. Wing events must pay for themselves – there is a breaking point if monthly expenses exceed income.

This year was the 98th anniversary of the formation of the Royal Canadian Air Force. In 1924 the Canadian Air Force was renamed the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) when it was granted the royal title by King George V. The RCAF existed as an independent service until 1968. On Feb. 1, 1968 unification of the Canadian Armed Forces took place and the Royal Canadian Navy, Canadian Army, and Royal Canadian Air Force were merged to form the Canadian Armed Forces. The three previously separate armed services were combined and ceased to exist as separate entities. Liberal Minister of Defence Paul Hellyer drove the change amid wide and heated debates. By 2014, many of the changes introduced by unification had been reversed.

The history of the RCAF begins in 1914, with the formation of the Canadian Aviation Corps (CAC) that was attached to the Canadian Expeditionary Force during WWI. It consisted of one aircraft that was never called into service. In 1918, a wing of two Canadian squadrons called the Canadian Air Force (CAF) was formed in England and attached to the Royal Air Force, but it also would never see wartime service. Post-WWI, in 1920, an air militia also known as the Canadian Air Force was formed in Canada.

From humble beginnings, Canadian pilots distinguished themselves in both wars, most often flying as part of a RAF squadron. Let's hope RCAF members, Wing members and all other aviation enthusiasts can celebrate the 100th anniversary of the RCAF in 2024.

Speaking of Air Cadets, congratulations to Jeremy Hansen on his selection as one of four astronauts on the 2024 Artemis II moon mission and the first from Canada to venture into deep space. This announcement continues the tradition of Canadian astronauts on space missions. Colonel Hansen credits Air Cadets with developing the discipline and self-confidence required to be accepted for Officer Training in the Canadian Armed Forces.

In 1988 at the age of 12, Jeremy Hansen joins 614 Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron in London, Ontario. His journey into aviation begins. In 1992, he earns his Air Cadet glider pilot wings in Trenton, Ontario. Jeremy earns his private pilot license and wings at the age of 17 in Cornwall, Ontario. This training will lead to his acceptance to Royal Military College Saint-Jean in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Quebec. In 1999 Jeremy graduates with a bachelor's degree in honours space science from the Royal Military College of Canada in Kingston, Ontario.


2003 – Colonel Hansen completes CF-18 Fighter Pilot training at 410 Tactical Fighter Operational Training Squadron.

2004-2009 - Serves as a CF-18 fighter pilot with 441 Tactical Fighter Squadron and 409 Fighter Squadron as well as

combat operations Officer at 4 Wing Operations where his responsibilities include effectiveness of NORAD Operations, Deployed Exercises and Arctic Flying Operations.

2009 – Colonel Hansen is one of two recruits selected by the CSA through the third Canadian Astronaut Recruitment Campaign.

2011 – He graduates from Astronaut Candidate



2013 – Jeremy participates in the European Space Agency's CAVES program in Sardinia, Italy, during which he lives underground for six days. He has the privilege of inspiring young Canadians by flying the historical Hawk One F-86 Sabre Jet.

2014 – He is a crewmember of NEEMO 19, where he lives and works on the ocean floor off Key Largo, Florida, for seven days simulating deep-space exploration.

2017 – Jeremy becomes the first Canadian to be entrusted with leading a NASA astronaut class, which means that he is in charge of the training astronaut candidates from the United States and Canada.

2023 – Jeremy Hansen is assigned to the Artemis II mission.

Personal info: Jeremy Hansen grew up in Southwestern Ontario. Born Jan. 27, 1976 in London, Ontario and raised on a farm near Ailsa Craig, Ontario, until moving to Ingersoll for his high school years. Lieutenant-Colonel Hansen is married with three children and recently based in Dallas, Texas.

Steve MacLean: Space Shuttle Columbia Oct. 1992 **Julie Payette:** Space Shuttle Discovery, first to dock at ISS, May 1999. Julie was first Cdn to visit ISS

Robert Thirsk: Space Shuttle Columbia June 1996, May 2009 – lived 6 months on ISS with Soyez crew

Bjarni Tryggvason: Aug. 1997 – 11 day mission as payload specialist for space science and hardware testing.
